

## SCRIPTURE LESSON: JOHN 13:12-17



John 13:12-17, When he had finished washing their feet, He put on His clothes and returned to His place. "Do you understand what I have done for you?" He asked them." #### HEAD The Mindset of Christ

Philippians 2:3-4, Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.

Philippians 2:5-6, In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather,

Philippians 2:7-8, He made Himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to death— even death on a cross!

## The Christian life is not one of self-interest but of self-sacrifice.


## HANDS For the lowly tasks
