**John 13:12-17, When he had finished washing their feet, He put on His clothes and returned to His place. “Do you understand what I have done for you?” He asked them.” You call Me ‘Teacher’ and ‘Lord,’ and rightly so, for that is what I am. Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another’s feet. I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you. **Philippians 2:3-4, Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit.**

**Philippians 2:5-6, In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather,**

**Philippians 2:7-8, He made Himself  
nothing by taking the very nature of a  
servant, being made in human likeness.  
And being found in appearance as a  
man, He humbled Himself by becoming  
obedient to death— even death on a  
cross!**
