LESSON TITLE: JESUS HEALS BROKEN HEARTS

REBUILDING BROKEN LIVES

Foundation Scripture: Luke 4:16-19

Luke 4:16-19, So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day and stood up to read. And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed; to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord."

Isaiah 61:1, The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on Me, because the Lord has anointed Me to proclaim good news to the poor. He sent Me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners.

Psalm 147:3, He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds (or sorrows).

Psalm 34:18, The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.

Lesson One: Jesus Heals Broken Hearts

To HEAL is to set free or to loosen from the detrimental effects of a shattered life.

What Can Break Your Heart?



God Knows Your Heart Needs Healing.

"Brokenhearted and Crushed in Spirit"

BRO'KEN-HEARTED, [break and heart.] Having the spirits depressed or crushed by grief or despair.

"Brokenhearted" is someone extremely unhappy, overcome, or overwhelmed by sorrow or grief.

A crushed spirit refers to the spirit that is losing or has lost the passion, desire, and energy to press into and deal with life.

Three Ways God Heals Broken Hearts:

1. Healing begins When We Surrender Our Thought Life to Him.

II Corinthians 10:3-6, For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ, and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled.

Philippians 4:8, Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is worthy of respect, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if something is excellent or praiseworthy, think about these things.

2. Healing Begins When We Embrace Our Identity in Him.
