Lesson Five:

The Prophetic Insights of Wells

1. Wells Represent Supply and Provision

**Numbers 21:16-17, From there they continued to Beer, the well where the Lord said to Moses, “Gather the people together and I will give them water.” Then Israel sang this song:
“Spring up, O well! Sing about it.**

**Philippians 4:19, And my God will supply all
your needs according to His glorious riches in
Christ Jesus.**

II Peter 1:3, God's divine power has given us everything we need for life and for godliness.

This power was given to us through the knowledge of the one who called us by His own glory and integrity.

“Where God guides, He provides.”

2. Wells Speak of Encounters with God

a. Grace Encounters

Gen 16:13-14

b. Worship Encounters

Genesis 26:25

c. Prophetic Encounters

Genesis 46:1-4

Genesis 46:1-4, So Israel set out with all that was his, and when he reached Beersheba, he offered sacrifices to the God of his father Isaac. And God spoke to Israel in a vision at night and said, “Jacob! Jacob!” “Here I am,” he replied. “I am God, the God of your father,” he said.

Genesis 46:1-4, “Do not be afraid to go down to Egypt, for I will make you into a great nation there. I will go down to Egypt with you, and I will surely bring you back again. And Joseph’s own hand will close your eyes.”

3. Wells of Salvation

**Isaiah 12:3, Therefore with joy you
will draw water from the wells of
salvation.**

John 4:14, "Whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain [well] of water springing up into everlasting life."

**Isaiah 55:1, "Listen! Whoever is thirsty,
come to the water! Whoever has no
money can come, buy, and eat! Come,
buy wine and milk. You don't have to
pay; it's free!"**

**Isaiah 12:2, “Behold, God is my
salvation; I will trust and will not be
afraid; for the Lord God is my strength
and my song, and He has become my
salvation.”**

4. Wells can Represent the Holy Spirit

**Jeremiah 2:13, "They have abandoned Me—
the Fountain of Living Water. And they have
dug for themselves cracked cisterns that can
hold no water at all!"**

**Wells represent the Holy Spirit's ability to
refresh us, quench our spiritual thirst,
cleanse us, and bring forth life wherever He
flows.**

**John 7:38, “Anyone who believes in Me may
come and drink! For the Scriptures declare,
‘Rivers of living water will flow from his
heart.’”**

**5. Wells are Symbolic of
Our Hearts**

**“...A fountain of gardens, a well of
living waters, and streams from
Lebanon.”**

Song of Solomon:4:15

**Proverbs 4:23, “Keep your heart with
all diligence, for out of it spring the
issues of life”**

**James 3:11, “Does a spring send forth
fresh water and bitter from the same
opening?”**

6. Wells are Places of Divine Appointments

A DIVINE APPOINTMENT refers to an
**extraordinary event in a believer's life or a
significant spiritual encounter with another
person.**

Four Examples of Divine Appointments:

a. Meeting a Life Partner

b. Career Opportunities

c. Encouraging Encounters

d. Acts of Kindness

**7. Wells Invite Us to
Co-Labor with God**

James 1:5, “If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.”

Wells, Gifts, and Inheritance

Deuteronomy 6:10-11
